



Notice of Intent to Operate a Home School

Select Your Method of Filing

A reminder that:

- Notice of Intents are not accepted in or for the month of [June](#).
- The State of North Carolina home school statistical year begins each July 1 and concludes the following June 30. Therefore, do not file your Notice of Intent until after July 1 of the home school statistical year in which you will begin your home school program.
- The registration of your home school is [not an annual event](#).

Please use only one (NOT both) of the following methods to file with DNPE your Notice of Intent to Operate a Home School in North Carolina (NOI):

Preferred Method: This automated electronic online method will save you time and postage and will insure priority handling at DNPE.

However, it requires that you provide your currently valid [e-mail address](#) to DNPE; and **within three hours**, fax a copy of your [diploma evidence](#). There are three steps involved in completing this process. No hard copies or electronic attachments can be submitted for this filing method. Your formal acknowledgment of its receipt by DNPE will be sent to your e-mail address (not to your US Postal Service address).

Click on [Preferred Method](#) if you now wish to begin the process of submitting your NOI electronically.

OR

Alternative Method: This non-electronic method is available for those who wish instead to submit their Notice of Intent via the US Postal Service and receive DNPE's acknowledgment of its receipt via their US Postal Service address. **No faxes or electronic submissions of any type are acceptable for this filing method.**
